TOWNSHIP BOARD RESOLUTION TO ADOPT (or AMEND) MASTER PLAN

WHEREAS, the Michigan Planning Enabling Act (MPEA) authorizes the Planning Commission to prepare a Master Plan for the use, development and preservation of all lands in the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission prepared a proposed new (OR updated) Master Plan and

WHEREAS, on 1-9, 2013 the STONA Township Board received and reviewed the proposed Master Plan prepared by the Planning Commission and authorized distribution of the Master Plan to the Notice Group entities identified in the MPEA; and

WHEREAS, notice was provided to the Notice Group entities as provided in the MPEA; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission held a public hearing on 1-1-2 to consider public comment on the proposed new (OR *updated*) Master Plan, and to further review and comment on the proposed new (OR *updated*) Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Township Board finds that the proposed new (OR *updated*) Master Plan is desirable and proper and furthers the use, preservation, and development goals and strategies of the Township;

WHEREAS, the MPEA authorizes the Township Board to assert by resolution its right to approve or reject the proposed Master Plan;

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

- 2. **Distribution to Notice Group.** The Township Board approves distribution of the adopted plan to the Notice Group.
- 3. Findings of Fact. The Township Board has made the foregoing determination based on a review of existing land uses in the Township, a review of the existing Master Plan provisions and maps, input received from the Planning Commission and public hearing, and with the assistance of a professional planning group, and finds that the new (OR updated) Master Plan will accurately reflect and implement the Township's goals and strategies for the use, preservation, and development of lands in STOWAC Township.
 - 4. Effective Date. The Master Plan shall be effective as of the date of adoption of this resolution.
